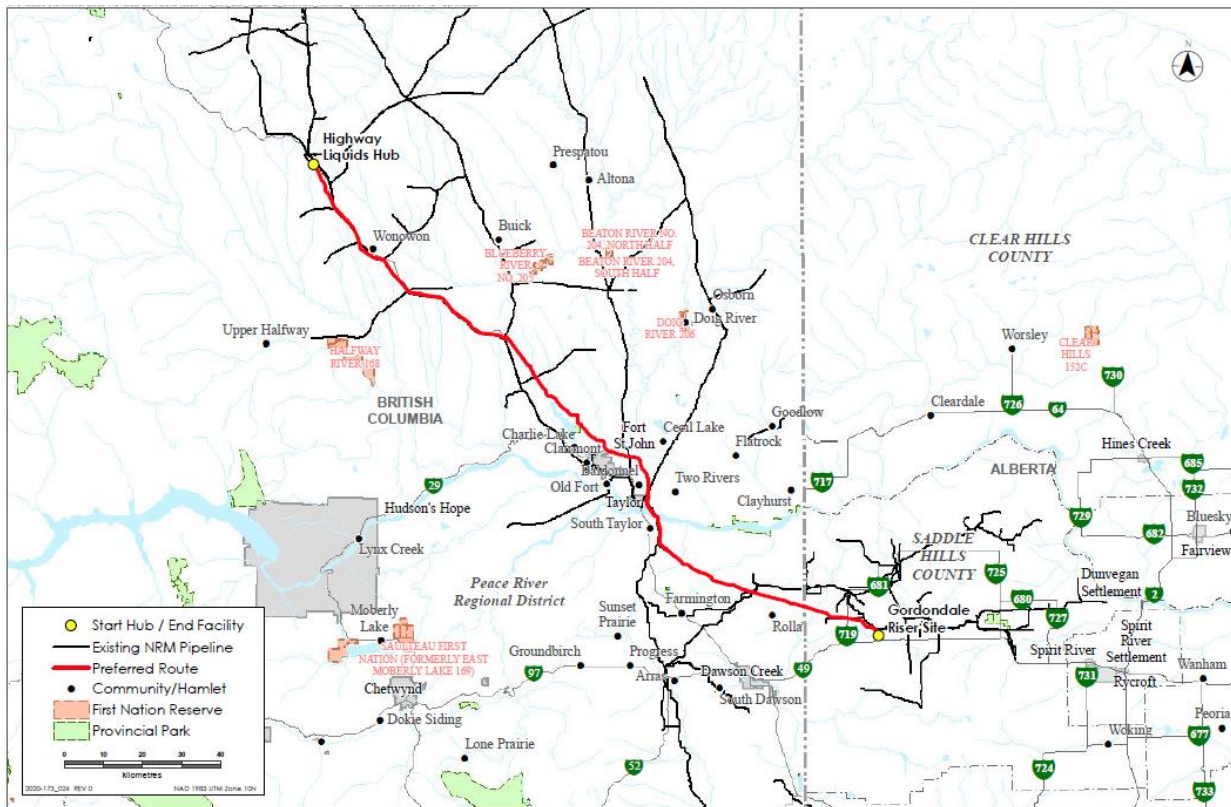


Notice of Public Hearing OH-001-2022

**Canada Energy Regulator (CER)
NorthRiver Midstream NEBC Connector GP Inc. (NorthRiver)
NEBC Connector Project (Project)**

The Project

On 18 November 2021, NorthRiver filed an application (<https://apps.cer-rec.gc.ca/REGDOCS/Item/Filing/C16186>) with the CER, pursuant to sections 182 and 183 of the *Canadian Energy Regulator Act*, for approval to construct and operate the Project (**Application**). The Project consists of, among other works, the construction and operation of two parallel pipelines, approximately 215 km long and 8-12 inches in diameter, which would transport condensate and natural gas liquids from NorthRiver Midstream Inc.'s Highway Liquids Hub, located northwest of Wonowon, British Columbia, to a riser site in the Gordondale area of Alberta.



Participation in the hearing

The Commission of the Canada Energy Regulator (**Commission**) will hold a public hearing for the Project if the Application is found to be sufficiently complete. If so, a Hearing Order would be issued outlining the hearing steps and deadlines, as well as guidance.

There are two manners in which to participate in such a public hearing:

A **commenter** may share their views with the Commission in a letter of comment. They cannot be asked questions about their letter of comment, nor can they ask questions about NorthRiver's or intervenors' written evidence or provide argument.

An **intervenor** may file written evidence, ask questions about NorthRiver's and other intervenors' evidence, and provide argument. An intervenor that files written evidence must answer any questions asked about their evidence.

Intervenors must register to participate in the hearing at www.cer-rec.gc.ca/participate. Registration will be open for two weeks, beginning on **18 January 2022**. Registrations must be submitted **on or before 1 February 2022**. Commenters are **not** required to register; however, commenters can sign up to be notified by email when commenting opens at the above link.
